

1098T Information

The 1098T form is available to all Allied Health Institute (AHI) students who had qualifying tuition and fees charged during calendar year 2011 to comply with the American Opportunity Credit, Hope Credit and Lifetime Learning Credit. For specific instructions, refer to the IRS publication 970: Tax Benefits for Higher Ed (PDF) or www.irs.gov for all IRS forms. The law requires schools to send this information to each taxpayer and to the IRS. However the IRS does not require taxpayers to submit 1098T forms when filing tax returns.

The 1098T forms will be available through AHI Student Portal. If you do not have access to the Student Portal please register yourself again by using your Student ID number, located at the top of the letter, and your date of birth. Step 1: Log on to <http://alliedhealth.ddstudent.com/alliedhealth/studentportal/>

Step 2: Click on Registration

Step 3: Set up your account. Create your own user name and password. Your student ID is the same number used to log you into classes (if you are unsure of your student ID, contact the school). Enter your date of birth, e-mail address and create a secret question/answer.

Step 4: Log in using your newly created user name and password. You should see the following

For each calendar year, we report the dollar amount billed for qualified tuition and related expenses. This amount will appear in box 2 of the 1098T form. We also report the total dollar amount of scholarships and grants, administered and processed by the school, this amount will appear in box 4 of the 1098T. These forms do not contain specific payment information.

Students and parents are advised to use personal financial records and consult professional tax advisors to determine the qualifying amount for tax purposes as the Institution cannot determine if a student qualifies for the tax credit or supply tax advice.

Frequently asked Questions Regarding 1098T Forms

- **What is the 1098T Tuition Statement?**

It is a statement of qualifying tuition and fees charged during a calendar year.

- **Who is eligible for 1098 forms?**

All Allied Health Institute students who incurred qualified tuition and fees during calendar year 2011. Students must have a [valid Social security number or Tax ID number and valid Mailing Address](#) on record with the Institution.
